SELECTION IN NDA

Candidates need to clear three Phases for the selection in NDA.

Written Examination: The Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) conducts the NDA Written Examination,

which consists of a written test. The exam assesses the knowledge in subjects like Mathematics, English, General Knowledge, Physics, Chemistry, History, Geography, and Current Events.

SSB Interview: Candidates who pass the written exam are called for a 5-day Service Selection Board (SSB) interview. The SSB interview includes various tests such as intelligence, psychological assessment, group tasks, and personal interviews. It evaluates your aptitude, personality, and suitability for a career in the armed forces.

Medical Tests: After clearing the SSB interview, aspirant will undergo a comprehensive medical examination to assess the physical and medical fitness.

The Final Merit is prepared on the basis of Written Exam, SSB Interview and Medical Test. Candidates with higher ranks in the merit list are offered admission to the National Defence Academy.

At NDA,

- Candidates undergo a comprehensive training program at the NDA, which includes both academic and physical training.
- The training period lasts for 3 years at the NDA, which is an Inter-Service Institution.
- The first 2.5 years of training are common for cadets from the Army, Navy, and Air Force.

ON PASSING OUT FROM THE NATIONAL DEFENCE ACADEMY:

On successful completion of the training, cadets are awarded degrees from Jawaharlal Nehru University in Delhi.

- Army Cadets: They receive degrees in B.Sc., B.Sc. (Computer), or B.A.
- Naval Cadets: They are granted a B. Tech degree.
- Air Force Cadets: They also receive a B. Tech degree.

Army Cadets

- Proceed to the Indian Military Academy (IMA), Dehradun, Known as Gentlemen Cadets.
- Undergo strenuous military training for one year aimed at developing officers capable of leading infantry sub-units. Successful completion leads to a Permanent Commission as Lieutenant, subject to medical fitness.

Naval Cadets

- Go to the Indian Naval Academy (INA), Ezhimala, selected for the Executive Branch of the Navy.
- Receive further training at INA for one year upon completion, promoted to the rank of Sub Lieutenant.

Air Force Cadets:

- Proceed to the Air Force Academy (AFA), Hyderabad, receive flying training for 1.5 years.
- Provisional Commission as Flying Officer after one year of training, after six months of additional training, absorbed as Permanent Commissioned Officers on probation for one year.

SYLLABUS:

- **Mathematics:** The mathematics syllabus includes topics such as algebra, matrices and determinants, trigonometry, analytical geometry, differential calculus, integral calculus, differential equations, vectors, statistics, and probability.
- **General Ability Test:** a. **English:** The English section tests the candidate's understanding for English grammar, vocabulary, comprehension, and cohesion in extended text. b. **General Knowledge:** The knowledge section covers topics like physics, chemistry, general science, social studies, geography, current events, history, freedom movement, Indian constitution, and administration.

The SSB (Services Selection Board) procedure for NDA selection consists of two stages: Stage I and Stage II. Here are the details:

Stage I:

- Officer Intelligence Rating (OIR) tests and Picture Perception & Description Test (PP & DT) are conducted.
- Candidates are shortlisted based on their performance in the OIR test and PP & DT.

Stage II:

- Interview, Group Testing Officer Tasks, Psychology Tests, and the Conference are conducted over a span of 4 days.
- The assessment is done by three different assessors: the Interviewing Officer (IO), Group Testing Officer (GTO), and the Psychologist.
- The assessors evaluate the candidate's personality holistically across all the tests.
- There is no separate weightage assigned to each test.
- Marks for the Conference are also allotted based on the candidate's initial performance in the three techniques and the decision of the Board.
- All the assessments and tests carry equal weightage in the overall evaluation process.

It's important to note that the assessors consider the candidate's performance and qualities across the various tests to assess their suitability for the armed forces.
